Improvements Scheduled 2009-2011

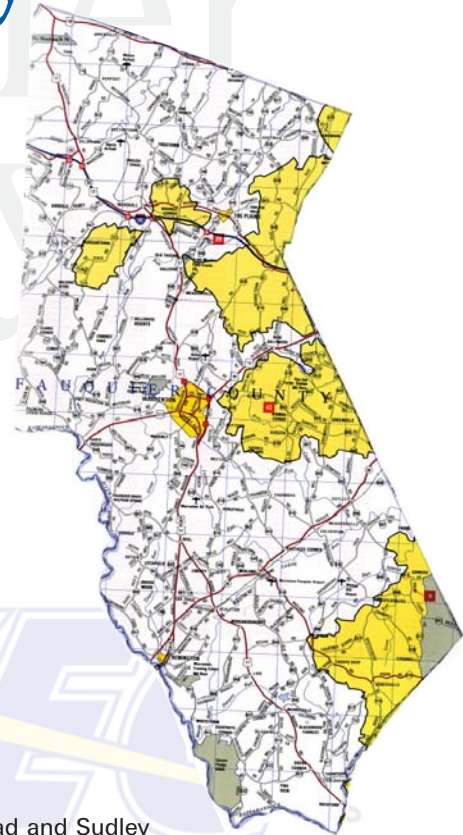
