

NOVEC Security Lights are Dark-Sky Friendly

Today, all new homeowner-requested security lights installed by NOVEC are designed to be dark-sky friendly. This means that the security lights help cut glare and reduce sky glow. These new lights do a better job of aiming light downward where it is needed for safety, security and visibility, rather than up into the sky.

If a customer already has an existing security light, they can pay a fee to have the light replaced or retrofitted to be dark-sky friendly.

Dark-Sky Friendly Lighting Example



This diagram shows the effect of dark-sky friendly lighting. You can see that there is no light shining toward the sky and there is essentially no glare. Virtually all of the light is aimed downward where it is needed.

Options for Homeowners

NOVEC's security light program can provide your home with extra light to brighten your path or provide added security.

For a low monthly fee (approximately \$10 to \$15), you can have a high-pressure sodium (HPS) security light located near your home. The lights utilize a photocell and operate automatically from dusk to dawn. Your security light fee will be included on your monthly NOVEC billing statement.

Depending on the proximity to your property of an electric pole and equipment, there may also be an installation fee for the security light. Once the light is installed, NOVEC covers all maintenance of the fixture at no additional cost.

NOTE: If a security light is repeatedly vandalized, NOVEC reserves the right to discontinue repairs unless paid for by the customer. If this situation occurs, NOVEC will also remove the light at no cost, if requested by the customer.

Reporting Security Light Outages

Many communities depend on NOVEC's lights to provide extra security and help keep neighborhoods safe. If a security light is out in your neighborhood, complete the online report at www.novec.com (click on "Security and Street Lights.") Or, call the Customer Service Center at 1-888-335-0500, Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. When you call, please be sure to have the exact street name and the location of the security light pole.

NOVEC is committed to keeping our security lights shining. However, with thousands of lights on our system it's difficult to monitor all of them. That's why we need your help to report security light outages.

Lighting Options

NOVEC offers three styles of security lights for residential customers. The most suitable design will be determined when you meet with a NOVEC distribution engineer.

M-250R2 Luminaire



- For residential streets, access roads, parking lots.
- 100 Watt HPS;

150 Watt HPS; 250 Watt HPS; 400 Watt HPS.

- Die-cast aluminum housing with gray paint finish.

SkyGard



- For outdoor work yards, commercial establishments, developments, and rural areas where reduced glare and full lighting is required.

- Unibracket on existing wood pole: 100 Watt HPS.
- Die-cast aluminum hood.

Salem Luminaire



- For residential areas, walkways, shopping centers.
- 70 Watt HPS; 100 Watt HPS; 150 Watt HPS
- Mounted on black fiberglass pole. Protected from vandalism in the head of the fixture by not having panels over the bulbs.
