4 Opt Out*

Under the Virginia Energy Choice Program, NOVEC must—*unless you instruct us otherwise*—provide your name, address, account number and electricity usage information to competitive service providers. These CSPs may contact you with offers to become your electricity supplier, with NOVEC *delivering* the power. If you don't want your information released, check this box. You may also call 703-335-0500 or 1-888-335-0500 or log on to www.novec.com to opt out or to reverse a prior decision. Opting out does not prohibit you from choosing an alternative electricity supplier.

5 Additional ORU Contribution


Write in any amount you wish to contribute to this customer-funded program which helps pay the winter fuel bills of your less fortunate neighbors. If you are an Operation Round Up participant, this amount is in addition to your rounded-up contribution.

Several years ago, your electric bill was expanded in order to include more information as required by the Virginia State Corporation Commission. Your bill is now “unbundled” or broken into separate fees covering the cost of delivery (distribution) and supply. The price you pay for receiving electricity has not changed although the price of wholesale power fluctuates along with the market, primarily due to the increasing cost of fuel used to generate electricity. 

Understanding Your NOVEC Bill

7 Service Charge

Reflects costs associated with building and maintaining a reliable delivery system for NOVEC customers. The level of electricity usage does not affect this cost.

8 Distribution Services

This is the price you pay for NOVEC to deliver electricity to your home or business. Note that the cost per kWh changes after the first 300 kWh delivered. The delivery of power remains regulated by the SCC. Even if you change suppliers, NOVEC will continue to collect this distribution service fee.

9 Local Utility Tax

A consumption-based tax imposed by your local government on energy services.

10 Consumption Tax

A state tax based on the amount of electricity you consume.

11 Electricity Supply Services

This is the actual price per kWh you pay for electricity supply (generation and transmission). This is the portion of your bill that can help when comparing rates between alternative suppliers.

12 WPCA Charge

Reflects monthly fluctuations in the cost of fuels used to generate electricity. Based on your kWh usage and approved by the SCC.

13 ORU Contribution

If you are an Operation Round Up participant, the amount you contribute each month will appear here. You can also write in additional ORU contributions on page 1 of your bill (see #3).

SAMPLE

Distribution Service - Is the government-regulated delivery of electricity that must be purchased through the distribution facilities of the local distribution company (NOVEC), by a retail cooperative member-customer.

Electricity Supply Service - Is the generation of electricity and its transmission to the local distribution company (NOVEC), on behalf of the retail cooperative member-customer. It may be purchased from any licensed provider in the competitive market but, if applicable, may result in a competitive transition charge.

15 Price To Compare: If you were to choose an alternate energy supplier, your price to compare this month is: \$0.0913 per kWh. You can use this price to evaluate offers from alternative energy suppliers.

Page 2 presents specific details about all the charges that comprise your bill. Definitions for many of the items are printed on the back of your bill.

14 CASH BACK

Cash Back margins are refunded to you as a NOVEC customer-owner, representing your share of the profits. Cash Back refunds are determined by NOVEC's board of directors and are based on the financial health of the Cooperative.

15 Price to Compare

If you were to choose an alternate energy supplier, your price to compare this month is shown here (\$0.0660 per kWh). You can use this price to evaluate offers from alternative energy suppliers.
