
HELP YOUR NEIGHBORS KEEP WARM THIS WINTER

ON AVERAGE, PARTICIPANTS CONTRIBUTE ABOUT 50 CENTS A MONTH.

For example, a bill that is \$69.54 is rounded up to \$70, and the extra 46 cents goes into the ORU fund. NOVEC pays all administrative costs of the program.
