sure it runs efficiently. This will help to extend life of the system and save money.

Look for ENERGY STAR equipment. When it's time to replace your cooling system, replace it with an ENERGY STAR-qualified model and reduce your energy costs by as much as 30 percent.

Bigger isn't always better. Too often, cooling equipment isn't sized properly and leads to higher electric bills. A unit that's too large for your home will not cool evenly and might produce higher humidity indoors. That's why it is important to talk to the energy-efficiency experts at NOVEC.
