- Modernize substation control and monitoring equipment at Bowman, Cardinal, Catharpin, Cedar Grove, Coles, Hicks, Independent Hill, Lindendale, Country Club, Evergreen, Garber, Minnieville, Smoketown, Sudley, and Wheeler Substations including several miles of fiber optic cable for substation communications
- · Install sectionalizing switch in the transmission line to improve reliability to the Linton Hall Road Corridor
- · Additional circuits for new load and improved reliability in the Lindendale area
- · These new substations on Logmill Road, Vint Hill Road, and at Innovation to serve new load and improve reliability
- · Expand Country Club substation
- Rebuild portions of Independence Hill substation
- Replace faulty overhead and underground conductor
