As part of the application process for Youth Tour, you must write an essay on **one** of the topics listed below.
The length of the essay should not exceed 350 words.

Choose one topic

1. What is one important issue facing our country that you feel will be most critical to your generation? Why? What recommendations would you make to legislators or to the President to bring about change in that area, and in what ways would you like to see that change manifest?
2. While in the nation's capital on Youth Tour, we will have an opportunity for a group audience with our Congressional representatives. What political issue would you like to bring to their attention? Discuss some specific points you would like to make about this issue.
3. Imagine an ice storm/blizzard, tornado or hurricane causes a power outage in your neighborhood that lasts a week or more. How would your day-to-day life change if you didn't have electricity for an extended period? What changes in lifestyle would you, your family and your neighbors have to make?

Completed application and your two (2) letters of recommendation must be received by February 4, 2019.
